Conditions and Specifications

GENERAL

CLASS ENTRY FEE: \$30 per class

In classes that combine Open, Amateur and/or Junior Horse divisions, exhibitor must declare which division they wish to compete in on their entry form. In Doma Vaquera, exhibitor must declare which level.

IALHA AND USEF RULES: This horse show is conducted in accordance with the USEF and the rules of the International Andalusian and Lusitano Horse Association, and is open to both purebred and half-bred horses. Each participant in this horse show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the rules of both the IALHA and the USEF. The rules of the USEF take precedence over the rules of any other association. See USEF Chapter AL for breed specific rules and specifications. The IALHA show rules shall prevail, if not covered by USEF rules.

IALHA DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE IN-HAND CLASSES: Classes shall be run and adjudicated according to 2010-2011 USEF rule book, SUBCHAPTER DR-2 DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING, but entries are limited to Andalusian, Lusitano, P.R.E., and Half Andalusian horses eligible to compete in shows sanctioned by the International Andalusian and Lusitano Horse Association. Classes will be patterned after those held at the 2011 IALHA National Show.

New Opportunity Classes for 2012!

\$5,850 Haras Dos Cavaleiros Working Equitation Championships

The discipline of Working Equitation is sweeping the globe, with high-level competition in both Europe and the Americas. Pin Oak will bring this discipline to the Houston area in 2012 with three levels of competition, Novice, Basic and Intermediate, sponsored by Lusitano breeders Haras Dos Cavaleiros.

Working Equitation is a discipline based upon the tradition of field work on ranches. It highlights the clear partnership between horse and rider, with an emphasis on athleticism, collection, and versatility. The sport began in Europe in the mid 1990s and has since expanded to the international level, governed by the World Association of Working Equitation (WAVE).

The three phases will run over two days, with the Dressage (20x40m ring test) phase on Thursday, March 22, and the Ease of Handling (obstacles for precision) and Speed (obstacles for speed) phases on Friday, March 23. The classes are open to all breeds. The Working Equitation Opportunity classes will be run using the IALHA 2011 rules available for download at <http://www.IALHA.org> with these exceptions: the Intermediate Level must be performed with one hand. Two hands are not allowed at the Intermediate Level. Updated Dressage tests for 2012 will be posted when they are available.

Opportunity Novice – Open to all breeds; 3 years and over

Opportunity Basic – Open to all breeds; 4 years and over

Opportunity Intermediate – Open to all breeds; 5 years and over

Cost for each phase is \$30. A competitor must enter all three phases to compete in the class, however, participants may enter one or two phases only. The class will be awarded the competition prizes advertised as well as ribbons for each phase. There is no additional entry fee for the Championships, which are scored using combined points from all three phases of each class. Pin Oak thanks Haras Dos Cavaleiros for sponsoring the cash prizes and trophies for the Working Equitation Championships at Pin Oak.

Specialty Andalusian and Half-Andalusian Yearling Futurities

Join Pin Oak in developing an exciting new competition for Andalusian and Lusitano breeders, by making a bet on your most promising youngsters—after they are born! Nominate your 2011 weanling colts or fillies by December 1 for \$75. Then bring them to Pin Oak in March for the competition, to be seen by other breeders and prospective buyers. All of the nomination fees will be returned as prize money in all four divisions: Specialty Andalusian Yearling Colts, Specialty Andalusian Yearling Fillies, Specialty Half-Andalusian Yearling Colts and Specialty Half-Andalusian Yearling Fillies. Normal class entry and stall fees apply. Nominations received between December 1 and January 1 will be accepted for \$100. No nominations will be accepted after January 1. Note: Yearlings may also show in the IALHA Two-and-under classes to be eligible for the Championships. Registry requirements for the Yearling Futurities are the same as for IALHA classes. REGISTRY REQUIREMENTS: All horses entered must be registered with or applied for registration with IALHA. Weanlings, yearlings and imported horses are eligible if both sire and dam are registered with IALHA or application has been made to register them with IALHA and a copy of the registration papers is on file with the show secretary. Copies of registration papers MUST be mailed with entries. Back numbers will not be issued to exhibitors until all papers have been checked.

MEMBERSHIP: Copies of USEF and IALHA membership cards, including amateur status, must be sent with entries or a non-member fee must be included with entry fee payment.

QUALIFICATIONS: A first, second or third-place finish qualifies the entry for the 2012 IALHA National Championship Show in that class. In IALHA classes at Pin Oak Charity Horse Show which combine Open and Amateur, or Open, Amateur and Junior Horse divisions, the top-placing three entries in each division will qualify. Entries must declare the division in which they wish to compete prior to the class. This division is rated "A" for USEF points.
