WPCSA SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER

Division is open to riders 12 years and under mounted on ponies/cobs and Half-Welsh. Riders, including the under saddle class, may not compete over fences in any other division except Short Stirrup equitation. Courses to be set at 18" with a minimum of 4 fences with 8 jumping efforts required. May either trot or canter the entire course. Over-fences classes must precede the under-saddle class. To be judged 100% on performance. To be eligible for the under-saddle class, pony must be entered and complete a course in at least one over-fence class. Under-saddle class animals shown both ways of ring at a walk, trot and canter. **(Art. 112.6)**

WPCSA SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION

Under Saddle (U/S): Division is open to riders 12 years & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. To be judged 100% on hands, seat, control of mount and suitability of mount. **Riders in this division may not compete over fences in any other division except short stirrup hunter.** Animals must walk, trot and canter. No High Point award. **(Art. 114.1)**

WPCSA HUNTER

Over fences (O/F): To be shown over a course of a minimum of six fences with eight jumping efforts of the required height. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Working classes judged 100% on performance. Animals not exceeding 13.2 hands will jump 2'0", animals exceeding 13.2 will jump 2'6".

Under Saddle (U/S): To be eligible, pony/cob must have shown in and completed an over fences class. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. May be required to gallop one way of the ring, but no more than eight animals at a time. **(Art. 112.5)**

WPCSA PLEASURE DRIVING

Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched, anywhere on the show grounds, will result in instant elimination and removal from the show grounds.

To be shown to a suitable two or four-wheeled vehicle, but not a viceroi, racing sulky, or Fine Harness rig, both ways of the ring at a walk, working trot and trot on, and stand quietly, and except for tandems, to back readily. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement, and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Working classes are judged 100% on performance. (Art. 113.1)

GENERAL

This show is conducted under the rules and regulations of the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America. All entries must be registered in the stud book of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of America, Inc. or the Canadian Pony Society and must be entered under their full registered name or, if under one year, be eligible for registration. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. All exhibitors must be members of USEF or pay non-member fee to participate in the show.

The Welsh Pony and Cob Show is also Provisional Silver rated by the WPCSA. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current WPCSA rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith, rules and specifications can be obtained from: WPCSA, 720 Green Street, Stephens City, VA 22655. 540-868-7669.

Copies of both front and back of registration papers must accompany entry form, as well as current measurement cards.

Each Section below will be awarded Champion and Reserve, except where noted.

Any cross entry into any hunter divisions will categorize you as a hunter.
